After three months of intensive labor, Lenora and I are safely under the roof of a nice 1-bedroom cottage-style home on the property of my daughter and son-in-law. No indebtedness in involved, thanks to our friends (especially the Fiala family) and our great heavenly Father. We still have outside painting to complete, but the inside in 100% finished. Special thanks to Fishermen Baptist Church of Bon Secour, Alabama, for providing housing through previous years. In our lifetime, home has been in many places due to ministry demands. It is a blessing to "Lord willing" have made our last move (next one up). We are very comfortable here and hope God can give us many more years of service. Thank you for your prayers.

Bro. Lemon (Proshenjit Sarkar), our director in Bangladesh, sent a report and pictures of souls saved in just the last few weeks. Sixteen adults have recently professed faith in Christ and were baptized in a croc-infested river (serious believers). The rivers flowing through the Sunderban now have six new churches built on their banks (I have personally visited four of those). Construction work has just begun on our base church and school there. I am anxious to see what God is going to do in the fishing fields of Bangladesh.

What a blessing to not only have a part in seeing souls saved and churches built, but to be able to help in the training of young men called to preach. Fishers of Men Bible School in India, the state of Orissa, will graduate six more men in the late spring. These church planters face hardship as never before, not just finances, but laws that forbid even the mention of Christ.

Fishers of Men Bible School in San Fernando City, La Union, Luzon, Philippines also moves forward with daytime and night students. As I've said before, it is a blessing to be able to visit there and see not just the self-supporting church, Fishers of Men Baptist Church, and school, but to have opportunities to minister to young churches established by graduates.

Each Wednesday when I am home, I now have the opportunity to visit and speak in the Escambia County Jail in Pensacola, Florida (1500 inmates). I met with the chaplain and he welcomed me to help with the spiritual condition of those locked behind bars. I will be assisting Bro. Henry Vick, who has had this ministry for years.

As yet we are not able to print materials as we would like, but the future could change. Hopefully we can at least put a "Cast Net-like" publication on our website from time to time. Be sure to visit fomm.org occasionally to see if that desire has been realized. Remember to listen to or download for future listening the radio broadcasts. The broadcasting range continues to grow as new stations pick up and broadcast the programs almost monthly. Such good response comes from even the other side of this globe. I ask for prayer that at my age I can present the gospel and spiritual meat effectively, not just have another program.

Special thanks to new churches who have added FOMMI to their mission program. We hope to see even greater things accomplished as we tarry until our Lord's return.
