One inmate started smiling and said he had been in Bon Secour and had worked for a seafood company there and passed by Fishermen Baptist Church many times, wondering about the things of God. It is good to know he now has trusted Christ for salvation, and is working on the correspondence course with his Bible. The heart of this ministry is for mariners and God even helped me to find one in a jail cell! Amen!

FOM Bible School in India and the Philippines are out for the summer. The students are doing soul winning and preaching in area churches for experience.

The work in Bangladesh continues to be a flourishing field for souls. The new churches have grown physically and spiritually. Our mission station is going up. The foundation is now in; walls will be going up next (remember all this is done by hand). This building will act as offices, school, church, etc. Finances for such have been supplied by you, our supporters, without even asking (again Psalm 37:5). Our representative there, Bro. Lemon, is doing an amazing job both on the physical and spiritual side. Lord willing, I will try to be on the scene as God directs.

The radio programs continue on. I am spoiled with listener communication. I now have so many dear friends globally. The gospel is going out by radio "waves", thanks to your help.

You folk keep us before the throne of grace often. (Someone prayed extra hard recently. I WAS sick for a whole week with an intestinal virus. Notice I said "WAS". Amen!)
