Welcome aboard again as we travel down the rivers, bays, and oceans of this world, casting the bread of the gospel. Because of your help, the rigging is maintained, power is sufficient, and we have plenty of fuel moving us forward. At this time I am thankful for climate change. The average temperature at home base has been 90+ degrees, but it is fixing to change. By the way, the climate has always been changing; summer...winter (Genesis 8:22). Thank God for the change, and God is changing it, not man. In Bon Secour October brings us our first northerly breezes from God's air conditioning. No matter the weather, it is always exciting to serve God.

PRAYER—Please keep us before the throne of grace especially the month of November. For three weeks, travel will bring us to our work on the island of Luzon, Philippines (20th anniversary), then on to Bangladesh for evangelism and encouragement. In December we will tell you more about the new converts, new churches, and new building in Bangladesh.

JAIL NOTES—Occasionally in my visits to Escambia County Jail, encouragement surfaces. (Most men's situation is sad, with many blaming others for their incarceration.) Through consistent lifting up of Christ, good fruit is seen. Recently a letter came in from an inmate who had been transferred to Walton County jail. He expressed how much the bible studies had meant to him on Wednesdays, and now he is saved and living for God. While in ECJ he had received and completed the Anchor of the Faith correspondence course, and upon completion received a new King James Bible. He wrote how much the Bible has helped him and of his love for it. No requests were made (usually many want something), only asked for prayer for his dad who is dying with cancer and lost—a good fulfillment of Eccl. 11:1.

RADIO NOTES—This reporting time includes what is known as “labor day” here in the USA (September 2). A strange thing happened on that day. We received a phone call from a person who said they knew us from the radio, and were travelling from near Washington, DC, to their home in Las Vegas and wanted to drop by to visit. We set a time to receive them, and upon arrival we had a wonderful couple of hours listening to them (many things in common). We also talked about the work of FOMMI. They commended us on our “labor” mission-wise and what it had meant to them personally (they knew primarily about the radio outreach). So, that was a shot in the arm for us on Labor Day. Maybe God just sent us a fulfillment of Hebrews 13:2.

We continue to travel to our supporting churches and also accept opportunities to speak in new churches who have shown interest in FOMMI. Recently we were in central Florida visiting old friends first in Chiefland (WTBH Radio and Long Pond Baptist Church with Pastor Cook) and were WELL taken care of by them, then on to Ocoee to be with long-time supporters at Victory Baptist Church and Christian School with Pastor Sam McFarland. We also travelled to Vicksburg, Mississippi, and renewed ties with Warrenton Independent Baptist Church (Pastor Marvin Curtis), as well as met new friends at Goodrum Baptist Church (Pastor Tony Monk). Another Sunday Pastor Ron Paul (Harvest Baptist Church, Columbia, TN) took us home for victuals after church—thanks Jane! We finished that trip with Pastor Brent Logan (Sweet Springs Baptist Church, Ardmore AL). It was a sweet place!
